Tina was currently serving as her sister JoAnn's contact person as JoAnn discerned her commitment to the Associate Relationship. The two had their tickets purchased and were excited to make the August trip to Oldenburg.

When Valentina signed her Associate Commitment in 2011, she was committed to sharing her gifts, talents, and prayers through mission work along with continuing to grow spiritually with the charism of Francis and Clare in her heart.

Valentina and JoAnn were here in Oldenburg for the Associates $40^{\text {th }}$ anniversary celebration. She had a great visit and was looking forward to the day she could come back.
